## Results suggest

This survey had a small number of self-selected respondents and there were several outliers regarding salary data. With that said, the results can be interpreted to suggest that higher salaries for English-language professionals at Swedish HEIs may relate in some way to the following factors:

- More significant factors (more than 2000 SEK difference in average salary)
- Personal
- Holding a doctoral degree
- Having other work tasks than translation/editing
- Being 55-64 years of age
- NOT having a degree in English/translation
- Being male
- Being employed full-time
- Organizational
- The HEI is located in the Stockholm area
- The position is located organizationally as part of the Communications unit


## - Less significant factors

- Personal
- Being a native speaker of English (between 1000 and 2000 SEK difference in average salary)
- Number of years at the HEI
- Years of experience
- Insignificant factors (the results of this survey do not indicate that salaries may relate in some way to the following factors)
- Personal
- Holding a Bachelor's vs. Master's degree
- Organizational
- Increasing population size for areas smaller than Stockholm (in fact, cities/towns with fewer than 100,000 had the higher salaries in this survey compared to cities with 100,000-300,000 inhabitants)
- Högskola vs. universitet


## Salary calculator suggestion

This survey suggests that an average of the following average salaries for the following categories could possibly be a meaningful starting point for salary discussions for an English-language professional position at a Swedish higher education institution.

- Educational level (Bachelor's/Master's vs. doctoral level)

| Bachelor's/Master's degree | 38337 |

- City/area size (Stockholm area vs. areas under 300,000 inhabitants) ${ }^{2}$

As an example, for a translator with a Master's degree who works at an HEI in a city of 100,000 inhabitants and who has work tasks other than English translation/editing (e.g. social media, language training and advising, consultation on procurement of external translating/editing services, translation to Swedish), you would take the average salary for those categories, i.e. 38337, 38165, and 40543, and average them and thus arrive at a suggested base monthly salary of 39015 SEK.

## Salary range suggestion

According to the results of this survey, the base salary range for English-language professionals at Swedish higher education institutions would thus most reasonably be considered to be 38061-44947 SEK per month as of November 2021 (these numbers the averages of all of the lowest and all of the highest salaries in each above category of educational level, city size, and work tasks).
